WHO WE ARE

A Global Healthcare Public Foundation (AGHPF) is a US-based non-profit organization. Since 2002, AGHPF has been assisting children, women, men and local health centers in resource poor areas in sub-Saharan Africa. With nearly 50 programs in eleven countries, AGHPF delivers services and conducts free HIV screens, clinical management seminars and IEC campaigns. AGHPF provides technical assistance to clinical laboratories and helps improve the lives and well-being of some of the world's most vulnerable.

WHAT WE DO

AGHPF is dedicated to improving the public health of children, women, men and their communities by enabling them reach their full health potential in the fight against HIV/AIDS. AGHPF was one of the few NGOs to deliver free HIV testing in rural African communities. AGHPF has:

- Sponsored training of VCT counselors
- Distributed over 1700lb of non antiretroviral medication in four countries
- Provided HIV counseling and testing services to thousands of people and brought care and support to many of them.
- Provides technical assistance to clinical laboratories in the US and Africa toward accreditation

BENEFACTORS & SPONSORS

U.S. government agencies, principally the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention remain important benefactors. Other major sponsors include Abbott Laboratories, Panacea Pharmaceuticals and e-Meditech. Increasingly, other government department agencies and the private sector are contributing to our work.

ACHIEVEMENTS

AGHPF's accomplishments are possible only through partnerships with governments, non-profit organizations business and community and faith-based organizations on the front line of the fight against HIV/AIDS

- 2007** In June, AGHPF was registered as an NGO in Kenya and opened its Nairobi office in September. AGHPF was awarded a quarter of a million dollars to provide technical assistance to CDC laboratories in Uganda and Botswana. Panacea Laboratories –USA and CDC-GAP lab Kisumu, Kenya, receive accreditation with AGHPF assistance.
- 2006** AGHPF sponsored 2000 free HIV test in Benin and Togo. AGHPF was awarded contract to provide technical assistance to Hygea Biofarm and Ndefru Medical laboratory - USA toward laboratory accreditation. In December, AGHPF started talks with the School of Public Health, University of Ghana to provide HIV prevention material.
- 2005** AGHPF is accepted into the Abbott Access Program. In March, AGHPF exhibits 260 field pictures at the Washington DC Art Center. AGHPF and Amadou Bello University, Zaria, Nigeria, sponsor HIV tests and starts program to reach migrant cattle headers. In April AGHPF is awarded Humanitarian Award. In October, AGHPF kicks off its "R U +ve" campaign.
- 2004** AGHPF worked with six Universities in Port Harcourt Nigeria, to distribute prevention brochures, condoms and gave seminars. In October AGHPF received the Mayor of Baltimore's Citation for public service.
- 2003** In December, AGHPF distributed medication in Benin, Togo and Cameroon. AGHPF organized soccer and dance events reaching over 3000 youths as a means to create awareness about issues of HIV/AIDS.
- 2002** In August, AGHPF is founded. In December AGHPF takes its first trip distributing 500lb of medication to some local health centers in West Africa.
